  - I have concerns about the lack of voice that the community has held in past projects. Changing transportation in a neighborhood often has unforeseen, negative impact that is never planned for.
  - If there are traffic changes on Central Avenue the traffic usually changes to New St. New St. already has traffic as cars use it as a short cut. New St. is a residential street with walking traffic & needs speed bump & other safety measures
  - Important to keep traffic moving & pedestrians safe very busy roadway for ingress & egress to city: also lots of pedestrians with Phillips Academy, NJIT, residents & Norfolk Street NJT passengers.
